Note: These codes are valid for billings to Medicare Administrative Contractors (MACs) for dates of service on or after October 1, 2011.

It is important to keep in mind that private payers and state Medicaid programs may continue to use or require use of the ICD-9-CM diagnosis codes from the October 1, 2010, release until January 1, 2012, or after.

In the absence of written notifications or bulletins from other payers, we recommend that you verify which version of ICD-9-CM to use for claims with each one of your other payers.
